# Dangerous and prohibited goods on board of an Avcon Jet Aircraft

According to the Commission Regulation (EC) 2015/1998 of 5 November 2015 laying down detailed measures for the implementation of the common basic standards on aviation security - 4. PASSENGERS AND CABIN BAGGAGE, 4.4 Prohibited articles:

Passengers shall not be permitted to carry into security restricted areas or on board an aircraft the following articles:

**(a) guns, firearms and other devices that discharge projectiles – devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury by discharging a projectile, including:**

- firearms of all types, such as pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns,
- toy guns, replicas and imitation firearms capable of being mistaken for real weapons,
- component parts of firearms, excluding telescopic sights,
- compressed air or CO2 guns, such as pistols, pellet guns, rifles and ball bearing guns,
- signal flare pistols and starter pistols,
- bows, cross bows and arrows,
- harpoon guns and spear guns,
- slingshots and catapults;

**(b) stunning devices – devices designed specifically to stun or immobilise, including:**

- devices for shocking, such as stun guns, tasers and stun batons,
- animal stunners and animal killers,
- disabling and incapacitating chemicals, gases and sprays, such as mace, peppersprays, capsicum sprays, tear gas, acid sprays and animal repellent sprays;

**(c) objects with a sharp point or sharp edge – objects with a sharp point or sharp edge capable of being used to cause serious injury, including:**

- items designed for chopping, such as axes, hatchets and cleavers,
- ice axes and ice picks,
- razor blades,
- box cutters,
- knives with blades of more than 6 cm scissors with blades of more than 6 cm measured from the fulcrum,
- material arts equipment with a sharp point or sharp edge
- swords and sabers;

**(d) workmen's tools – tools capable of being used either to cause serious injury or to threaten the safety of aircraft, including:**

- crowbars,
- drills and drill bits, including cordless portable power drills,
- tools with a blade or a shaft of more than 6 cm capable of use as a weapon, such as screwdrivers and chisels,
- saws, including cordless portable power saws,
- blowtorches,
- bolt guns and nail guns;

**(e) blunt instruments – objects capable of being used to cause serious injury when used to hit, including:**

- baseball and softball bats,
- clubs and batons, such as billy clubs,
- blackjacks and night sticks,
- martial arts equipment;

**(f) explosives and incendiary substances and devices – explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of aircraft, including:**

- ammunition,
- blasting caps,
- detonators and fuses,
- replica or imitation explosive devices,
- mines, grenades and other explosive military stores,
- fireworks and other pyrotechnics,
- smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating cartridges,
- dynamite gunpowder and plastic explosives.
